Wildlife training day courses

Most workshops incorporate an indoor session and a field trip onto the nature reserve. Please ensure you are dressed for the outdoors and wear stout shoes or walking boots. If you have any medical conditions which we should be made aware of, please ensure you pass this information to us when booking. Courses generally start at 10am and will finish by 4pm.

All day courses are £25 per person. Please note that lunch is not included in the price. Attenborough Nature Centre has a café on site or you can make your own arrangements.

SATURDAY 8th May - Freshwater invertebrates with David Goddard

This course will cover the methods for collecting freshwater invertebrates, how to identify them and how to make use of the invertebrates found to make an assessment of water quality.

SATURDAY 5th June - Butterflies with David Goddard

This course will cover the identification features of butterflies, their life cycles and biology. The session will also cover setting up butterfly transects and involve using butterfly nets for sampling.

SATURDAY 19th June - Plants with Kevin Caley

This course will introduce the ecology of the main groups of plants that flower on the Reserve and how to identify them in the field.

SATURDAY 26th June - Insects with Kevin Caley

This course will introduce the main insect groups that are found on the Reserve and their main characteristics and general biology as well as how to identify them.

SATURDAY 16th October - Birds with Kevin Caley

This course will look at the birds found at Attenborough, their biology, behaviour, how to identify them and where to look for them.

SATURDAY 23rd October - Fungi with Diane Meares

This course aims to give a fun and practical beginners guide to fungi and to understand what fungi is, why it is important and how to being to identify fungi in the field.

Talk and Walks

These short half day sessions are ideal introductions to the wildlife found at Attenborough. The typical format is a short introductory talk inside the Centre followed by a field walk on the Reserve. Most sessions are £5 per person, unless stated below:

Saturday 15th May - Moth Night with David Fox. Talk at 2pm and moth watch in evening (time to be confirmed). £5 for both or £3 if booked separately.

Saturday 12th June - Dragonflies and damselflies with David Goddard. 10am to 11.30 talk. 1pm start for field walk.

Saturday 3rd July - Insects with Brian Wetton - 1.30pm start.

Saturday 10th July - Pond dipping for adults with Alan Heath and Tom Hartman - 10am to 12.30pm.

Saturday 17th July - Wild flowers with Graham Bowden - 10am to 2pm.

Saturday 21st August - Butterflies with Nigel Slater - 1.30pm to approximately 4pm.

Saturday 6th November - Fungi with the Nottinghamshire Fungi Group. 10am to 1pm.
